



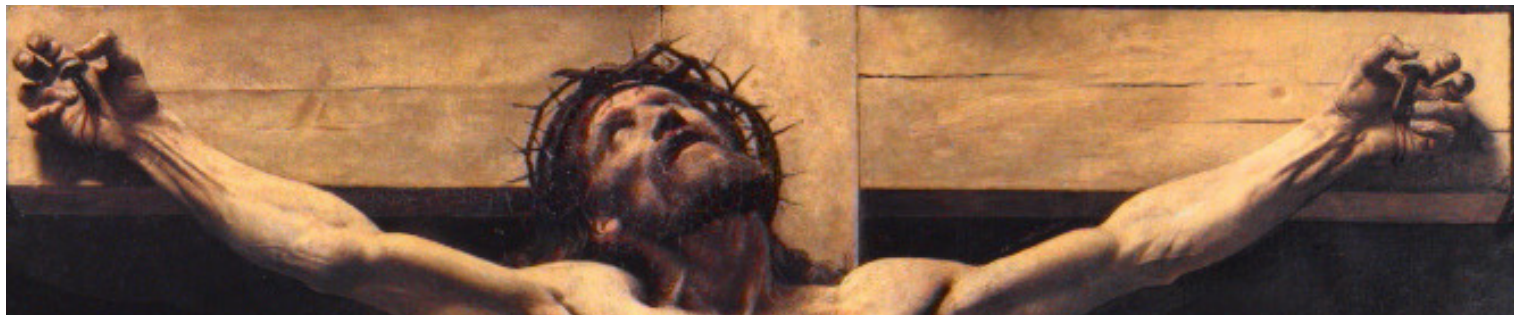
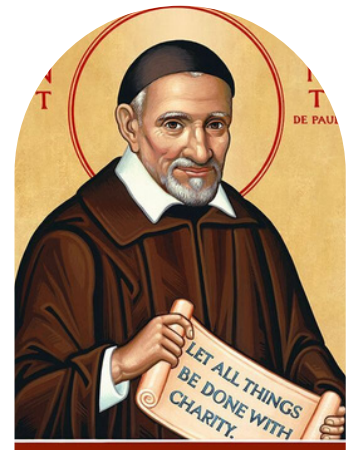
SAINT JOSEPH WITH SAINTS AIDAN & OSWALD

The Society of Saint Vincent De Paul (SVP) was founded in 1833 by a group of students in Paris, under the leadership of Frederic Ozanam. The students served the poor of the city, inspired by the life of St Vincent de Paul. In 1844 a group of men came together in London and started the first group in Britain.

All are invited to join the SVP members at Mass on Tuesday 9th September - Feast of Bl. Frederic Ozanam - at St. Joseph's, 7pm, to pray for the work of the SVP. Social time after.

The SVP Society's main objective is the relief of poverty in all its forms. Various Manchester SVP Societies run food banks, uniform recycling centres, prison visits, etc., though our main objective is to offer people the hand of friendship by visiting the sick and housebound.

Monday & Friday: Nativity of Mary and her holy name

We celebrate the birthday of the Blessed Virgin Mary and her name being a holy name to invoke as mother and protector.

Tuesday: Bl Frederick Ozanam

Born in France, 1813, he was studying when he decided to call his generation to action. When asked 'what are you doing to help the poor' he gathered a group of friends to begin the SVP: **'turning concern into action'**

Wednesday: St. Ambrose Barlow

Born in Manchester, he studied for the priesthood in Douai and Valladolid during the penal times. He returned to England but was captured on Easter Sunday 1641, and later martyred.

Saturday: St John Chrysostom

He was born in Antioch. After a thorough education, he took up the ascetic life. He was ordained to the priesthood, and became a fruitful and effective preacher.
