






#### **SVP AWARENESS MONTH**

The Society of Saint Vincent De Paul (SVP) was founded in 1833 by a group of students in Paris, under the leadership of Frederic Ozanam. The students served the poor of the city, inspired by the life of St Vincent de Paul. In 1844 a group of men came together in London and started the first group in Britain.

All are invited to join the SVP members at Mass on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> September - Feast of Bl. Frederic Ozanam - at St. Joseph's, 7pm, to pray for the work of the SVP. Social time after.

The SVP Society's main objective is the relief of poverty in all its forms. Various Manchester SVP Societies run food banks, uniform recycling centres, prison visits, etc., though our main objective is to offer people the hand of friendship by visiting the sick and housebound.

He was born in Antioch. After a thorough education, he took up the ascetic life. He was ordained to the priesthood, and became a fruitful and effective preacher.
