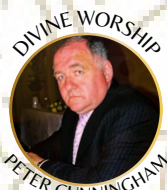
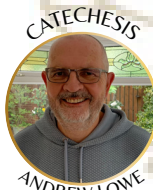
PARISH COUNCIL

When Bishop John Arnold appointed me to be the Parish Priest of both Saint Joseph's, Shaw & Crompton, and Saints Aidan and Oswald, Royton, canonically I received certain duties. Primarily, it is to share in the threefold ministry of the Bishop to teach, govern, and sanctify. These roles are then placed within the pastoral situation of the Parish(es) entrusted to the Priest.

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

Monday: St Louis

Became King of France at the age of 12. He was noted for his spirit of prayer and penitence and for his love for the poor. He ran his kingdom not only to give peace to the people and economic stability but also for their spiritual good.

Tuesday: Bl. Dominic Barberi

Dominic Barberi was born near Viterbo, Italy, in 1792 and joined the Passionist Order, urged on by an inner assurance that God called him to work as a missionary in England. He received many converts, including St. John Henry Newman, into the Church.

Wednesday: St. Monica

She was born at Thagaste in Africa of a Christian family. She was married young, to Patricius, and among her children was Augustine. She was tireless in her prayer for her son's conversion and is patroness of persistent prayer.

Thurs.: St. Augustine

Augustine had a brilliant legal and academic career, but after his conversion he returned home to Africa and led an ascetic life. He was elected Bishop of Hippo and spent 34 years looking after his flock, teaching them, strengthening them in the faith and protecting them strenuously against the errors of the time.
