#### SAINTS OF THE WEEK

**Tuesday:** St. Mary Magdalen She is a unique and important character in the story of the Resurrection, chosen by Christ as one of the first witnesses of the event that changed the world.

**Wednesday**: St Bridget of Sweden (1303 - 1373)

After a pilgrimage to the shrine of St James at Compostela in Spain, Bridget and her husband Ulf decided to spend the rest of their lives in monasteries.

She had many mystical visions, many about the Passion of Jesus.

Thursday: St James, Apostle
He was the brother of St John and,
like him, a fisherman. He was one of
the witnesses of the Transfiguration
and one of those who slept through
most of the Agony in the Garden.
He was the first of the apostles to
be martyred.

Relics of St James were brought to Spain some time after his martyrdom, (perhaps early, perhaps as late as 830), and his shrine at Compostela, which is a major pilgrimage site to this day.
