ADVENT WEEK 3: JOY
















The countdown to Christmas intensifies with Gaudate Sunday, where we celebrate 'joy' at the coming of Christ at Christmas, and the 'O' antiphons from the 17th - 23rd December. The antiphons are usually sung phrases used in monasteries, where the community would sing the lyrics relating to the messianic titles of The Christ:

- O Sapientia (O Wisdom),
- O Adonai (O Lord),
- O Radix Jesse (O Root of Jesse),
- O Clavis David (O Key of David),
- O Oriens (O Dayspring),
- O Rex Gentium (O King of the nations),
- O Emmanuel (O God with us).

the first letter of each phrase, read in reverse, makes a hope-filled Latin phrase: 'Ero Cras', which means, 'tomorrow, I will come'

Perhaps the antiphons will give us an opportunity to delve deeper into the Christmas mystery.
