PARISH COUNCIL

LECTIO DIVINA COURSE

Lectio Divina means 'prayerful reading', which relates to an ancient practise in the Church of praying with the Scriptures. We will be hosting a Lectio Divina course biweekly - 4 sessions over 8 weeks. The sessions will help us explore the Word of God and make the practise of praying with the scriptures - encountering God - a devotional habit.

St. Jerome once wrote that "ignorance of scripture is ignorance of Christ". We seek to know Him, love Him, and serve Him in this life and be happy with Him in the next. Lectio Divina will be the vehicle of change we seek; of guidance we desire; and reassurance of God-with-us.
